Between the USDA Forest Service, Beaverhead-Deerlodge National Forest And the

State of Montana, Department of Natural Resources and Conservation

This cost share agreement is between the agencies identified above, as negotiated for the following incident in accordance with the 2023-2027 Statewide Cooperative Fire Management and Stafford Act Agreement (23-FI-11015600-048) executed between the parties on 1/26/2023. The purpose of this agreement is to allocate financial responsibility and to describe the cost division.

Other conditions relative to this agreement:

- 1. Responsibility for tort claim costs will not be a part of this agreement. Responsibility for these costs will be determined outside this agreement.
- 2. Costs for accountable, sensitive, and durable property purchased by each agency will be charged directly to that agency.
- 3. Non-suppression rehabilitation costs are the responsibility of the jurisdictional agency.

Protecting Agencies' Strategies:

Multiple suppression strategies of point protection, monitoring, and full suppression, engaging the fire where the safety and access concerns could be addressed.



Cost Share Methodology and Rationale:

Costs will be shared by a % of effort methodology where the Forest Service will assume 100% of the effort and financial responsibility. The rationale for this decisions is that the acres burned on county protection were minimal on a private inholding surrounded by NFS lands in a remote location and make up less than 1 percent of overall acres. Montana DNRC will bill for their costs as outlined in the Montana Cooperative Fire Management Agreement billing procedures.
