ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

THESE WATER RIGHTS WERE PREVIOUSLY CHANGED BY UNPERFECTED WATER RIGHT CHANGE APPLICATION NO. 76N 30027719. PROVISIONAL PERMIT NOS. 76N 81519-00, 76N 85780-00, AND 76N 97278-00 ARE PERFECTED PERMITS, WHILE PROVISIONAL PERMIT NO. 76N 30016270 IS UNPERFECTED.

In general, the Department will make a draft preliminary determination to grant or deny this application within 60 or 120 days of the date the application is deemed and correct and complete (60 days if a preapplication meeting was held, 120 days if a preapplication meeting was not held). If the preliminary determination is to grant the application, the application will again be published in a local newspaper and a notice will be sent to anyone who submitted a public comment, along with appropriators who, according to the department records may be affected by the proposed appropriation. Individuals will have 30 days to submit an objection under §85-2-308, MCA, after the application has been published in the newspaper.
